Objectives that are in red are a Y2 statutory requirement and individual words highlighted red are from the Y2 non-statutory example words and their exceptions. The additional words and sets (in black) either reinforce the rule/ pattern being taught; practise a spelling rule linked to a Y2 statutory requirement or practise the common exception words (with an asterisk). Each set of spellings contains 10 words linked to the objective.
